Since the software is focused on professional photographic requirements, it supports editing and managing of files in both tethered and portable shooting modes.

Leaf Capture 11.5 is an important release that includes a number of major upgrades to the Leaf Aptus-II firmware. A new Leaf GUI provides an intuitive and user-friendly upgrade to Leaf's previous one. Designed with the needs of professional photographers in mind, it offers improved workflow processes and quicker access through innovative tools like *favorite settings*. The new Leaf GUI's outdoor theme also makes exterior shooting much easier by improving visibility in high glare and reflection situations.

Leaf Capture 11.5 also enables photographers to leverage pre-configured lens calibration files while shooting on the go. Lens calibration files fix effects like lens fall-off and color casts which can appear when shooting with wide angle lenses. Now available while shooting to CF card. Lens Calibration when shooting to Compact Flash card for Aptus II and AFi II\* backs.

Lens Calibrations pre-created in Leaf Capture can be used when shooting to CF card. **Note:** The Lens Calibration names for CF card are limited to a maximum of 32 characters.

Accelerated performance when shooting to CF card with Aptus II and AFi II\* backs



Faster start-up. (First startup prepares the CF card and subsequent startups are quicker). \* AFi II backs manufactured by Kodak will not receive the firmware upgrade.

Instructions for preparing and loading a Lens Calibration file for CF card:

- 1. Quick format a CF card in the Aptus II back.
- 2. Connect the back to the computer and create a Lens Calibration for **tethered** use.
- 3. In Leaf Capture main menu click Camera/Lens Calibration File/Create File for CF card...

- 4. Browse to the Lens Calibration file from step 2.
- 5. Give a meaningful name to the lens calibration for CF and specify its location on the Hard Disk.
- Copy the Lens Calibration for CF to the following folder on the CF card: CF/LEAFDM SYS/Lens\_Calibration



- 7. Insert the CF card into the back.
- 8. Load the Lens Calibration file:

Tap Camera  $\rightarrow$  Camera Settings  $\rightarrow$  Lens Calibration  $\rightarrow$  Select desired lens calibration  $\rightarrow$  Tap OK



## **Fixed issues**

Improved colors when shooting under Tungsten lighting for Aptus-II 5 and Mamiya DM22.

## Uploading firmware to camera backs

Firmware will be updated for Aptus-II backs including the new GUI. Firmware for other backs will be updated depending on their model type and current firmware.

Aptus II	Yes
AFi II*	Yes *(with serial no. starting with the letters "LI").
Mamiya DM	Minor bug fix. (Does not include New GUI, Lens Calibration for CF card and accelerated startup).
Aptus, Aptus S	No
AFi	No
AFi II (Kodak, with serial number starting with "LF").	No

When connecting a Leaf Aptus, Aptus-II, AFi-II or Mamiya DM to Leaf Capture 11.5 for the first time, follow this procedure to ensure that the new firmware (if applicable) will be loaded to the camera back:


Launch the Leaf Capture software.

Connect your camera back to the computer.

Depending on your hardware, when you connect your camera back to the Leaf Capture software, one of the following messages may appear:

00	Leaf Capture 11
	The firmware in your camera back is not compatible with the Leaf Capture application. To load compatible firmware to your camera back, click OK. To disconnect without loading, click Cancel.
	Cancel OK





Click OK. The camera back firmware is updated. You will see a progress bar at the bottom-left corner of the Leaf Capture window.

This process may take up to 10 minutes.

Do not disconnect the FireWire cable and do not mount or dismount a CF card during this process.

## About Leaf Capture installation

### **Installing Leaf Capture**

The Leaf Capture installation wizard requires that no other applications are running during the installation. If you are working in other applications, make sure you save your work before launching the Leaf Capture installation.

### Computer restarts after installation

If a driver that is new to your computer is installed during the Leaf Capture version 11.5 software installation, Leaf Capture restarts your computer at the end of the installation. If you are working in other applications, make sure you save your work first.

#### Preferences are reset after installation

The installation automatically resets your Leaf Capture preferences. Note: If you have multiple user accounts, the preferences are reset only for the user who installs the Leaf Capture software. All other users must manually reset their preferences:

 Locate Applications > Leaf Capture 11 > Utilities, and double-click Reset Preferences.
